SCAFFOLD/STAIR TOWER USERS

SITE-SPECIFIC SAFETY TRAINING AND DOCUMENTATION IS REQUIRED BEFORE YOU MAY ACCESS THIS STAIR TOWER. VIOLATORS WILL BE CONSIDERED TRESSPASSERS AND WILL BE REMOVED FROM SITE.

This scaffold has been installed and erected to comply with the manufacturer's recommendations and Subpart L of the OSHA Regulations for Construction.

Electrical Hazards: None

Fall Hazards: None

Fall Protection and Falling Object Protection: Guard Rails, Mid-Rails & Toe Boards Installed. Wear Hard Hats and Eye Protection

Proper Use of Scaffold/Tower: This is designed for workers to gain access from the ground to the roof elevation and visa versa. No work will be performed from the Scaffold.

Proper Handling of Materials: DO NOT REMOVE any of the scaffolding components. Small, light-weight tools and materials can be hand-carried up or down the Scaffold. Hoists, Pulleys and handlines must not be attached to the scaffolding.

Maximum Intended Load & Capacity of Scaffold: This scaffold is designed and capable of supporting, without failure, its own weight and at least 4 times the maximum intended load.

Guidelines for Use

The stair tower must be inspected, tagged and SIGNED daily by the Competent Person. If it hasn't been signed- DON'T USE IT!

If any deficiencies are observed (loose connection or stair tread, missing guard rail or toe board, etc.), notify your Supervisor and Competent Person IMMEDIATELY!

Personal Protective Equipment (hard hats & eye protection) must be worn at all times.

Trash, debris, loose materials must be removed from scaffolding immediately.

Never climb the scaffold bucks or cross braces.

DO NOT REMOVE any components (fall protection, bracing, etc.) of the scaffold.

When utilizing the stair tower- Walk, DON'T RUN.
